**Satyagraha.** (Sanskrit and Hindi: "holding onto truth") It is a concept introduced in the early 20th century by **Mahatma Gandhi** to designate a determined but resistance to evil.

According to this philosophy, *satyagrahis*—practitioners of satyagraha—achieve correct insight into the real nature of an evil situation by observing a nonviolence of the mind, by seeking truth in a spirit of peace and love, and by undergoing a rigorous process of self-scrutiny.

*Satyagrahis* always warn their opponents of their intentions; satyagraha forbids the use of secrecy to one's advantage. Satyagraha seeks to conquer through conversion: in the end, there is neither defeat nor victory but rather a new harmony.

Satyagraha draws from the ancient Indian ideal of *ahimsa* ("noninjury").
